Description	Explanation
History	: Our faculty was discussed as Karadeniz Technical University Faculty of Law in the decision of the University Senate dated 18.05.2007 and numbered 211/10, and was established with the decision of the Council of Ministers dated 10.09.2007 published in the Official Gazette dated 26.12.2007 and numbered 26738. With the first group of twenty students, it started its education and training activities within Gazi University Faculty of Law in 2008/2009 academic year. During the process of continuing its education and training, our faculty was affiliated to Trabzon University with the Law No. 7141 on the Amendment of Higher Education Law and Some Laws and Decree Laws published in the Official Gazette dated 18.05.2018 and numbered 30425.
Qualification Awarded	: Graduates of the Faculty of Law are awarded a bachelor's degree in LAW.
Level of Qualification (Short Cycle , First Cycle , Second Cycle, Third Cycle)	: This programme is an undergraduate programme.
Specific Admission Requirements	: The application requirements for students who graduated from secondary education institutions in Turkey are to get enough points in the field of Equal Weight from the Higher Education Institution Exams (YKS) and to have a high school or equivalent school diploma. Foreign students who graduated from a school equivalent to Turkish high schools and meet the application requirements can also apply to study at the Law undergraduate programme of our university. Foreign students will be accepted for evaluation of their applications with the Foreign National Student Examination (YÖS) conducted by ÖSYM. In addition, candidates applying for foreign student quotas must also meet the registration requirements of the undergraduate programmes. In the 2019 YÖS guide, two quotas are allocated to TRU Faculty of Law.
Specific Arrangements For Recognition Of Prior Learning (Formal, Non-Formal and Informal)	: Recognition of learning at Trabzon University is carried out within the scope of the "Regulation on the Principles of Transferring Between Associate and Undergraduate Degree Programmes in Higher Education Institutions, Double Major, Minor and Inter-institutional Credit Transfer". Graduates of the Vocational School of Justice who are successful in the Vertical Transfer Examination (DGS) can be accepted to continue their education to obtain a bachelor's degree.
Qualification Requirements and Regulations	: Students who successfully complete all the courses in the programme (equivalent to 240 ECTS in total) and obtain a grade point average of at least 2.0 out of 4.00 are awarded a bachelor's degree in the field of LAW.
Profile of The Programme	: TRU Law Undergraduate Programme has switched to an annual curriculum as of the 2019/2020 academic year. The curriculum of the four-year undergraduate programme is designed to provide basic knowledge in legal education. In this context, the curriculum includes basic compulsory courses on private law and public law, as well as more specific elective courses related to areas of specialisation. Elective courses are given on a semester basis. According to the regulation in force, students are obliged to attend and the principle of passing the course is applied in our faculty. Since the 2019-2020 academic year, the quota of the law faculty is 250 students.
Occupational Profiles of Graduates With Examples	: The job opportunities for graduates of the Faculty of Law are quite wide. Graduates of the Faculty can find a job at every level of the public or private sector, provided that they are successful in the competition exams and fulfil the requirements for the practice of the profession. District governor, judicial judge-prosecutor, administrative judge-prosecutor, undersecretary, lawyer, notary public, inspector (bank-ministry...etc.), assistant expert (legal) are some of the positions where graduates of the Faculty of Law can be employed.
Access to Further Studies	: Graduates of the Faculty of Law who have completed their four-year undergraduate education can continue their postgraduate education if they wish and provided that they fulfil the necessary conditions. Students are admitted to postgraduate programmes by evaluating the candidates who meet the undergraduate success level, ALES, foreign language knowledge level and other qualifications required according to the characteristics of the programmes and specified in the announcements. Applicants must have a bachelor's degree from the Faculty of Law and obtain a certain standard score from ALES. If the undergraduate education is completed abroad, the equivalence certificate issued by the Council of Higher Education is required. In addition to the undergraduate graduation certificate and ALES result document, applicants must also have documents showing foreign language scores obtained from YDS, YÖKDİL or one of the exams whose equivalence is determined by the Interuniversity Board. Other conditions are determined and announced by the Institute Administrative Boards.
Examination Regulations, Assessment and Grading	: The success of the students in the compulsory annual courses is evaluated in TWO stages: a midterm exam and a final exam. For the elective courses that are opened periodically, the grades are entered into the database by the instructor in the form of a mid-term exam and a final exam. Success score, It is calculated by adding 40% of the midterm / midterm exam score to 60% of the final / year-end or make-up exam score. In order to be considered successful in a course, the student must receive a grade of at least 50 and above (CC as a letter grade). If the grade point average of the courses taken in a semester is above 2.00, a student is also considered successful in the course in which he / she receives a grade between 40-49 (DC as a letter grade).
Graduation Requirements	: To successfully complete all the courses in the programme (240 ECTS credits in total) and to have a GPA of at least 2.0 out of 4.00.
Mode of Study (Full-Time, Part-Time, E-Learning)	: This is a full-time programme.
Address, Programme Director or Equivalent	: Trabzon Üniversitesi Hukuk Fakültesi, Karadeniz Teknik Üniversitesi Kanuni Kampüsü, Ortahisar/Trabzon.
Facilities	: The education and training activities of the Faculty of Law are carried out in the classrooms, meeting and lecture rooms in the Faculty of Law building. Our department has the facilities of 1 reading room, 1 meeting room and 1 seminar room. In terms of faculty facilities, the printed and electronic resources of Trabzon University Library are available to students, and our students can also benefit from the subscribed databases.
